## 2021 ISONG Congress Expert Lecture Review Criteria and Grading Guidelines

Thank you for reviewing the “Expert Lecture” abstracts for the 2021 ISONG Congress. These lectures are an opportunity to hear in-depth expertise on genetic/genomic related topics from clinical practice, research, education, or policy initiatives. Lectures may encompass a broader perspective than an individual initiative or research study. Topics may be appropriate for a broad ISONG audience (such as a plenary session) or of greater interest to a more focused audience (such as a concurrent session).

Abstract grading is based on the following criteria:

1. Relevance/importance of expert content
  - a. To current clinical practice, state of research of topic area, education initiatives or policy implication (outline, objectives).
  - b. Implications for future clinical practice, research, education initiatives or policy development (outline, objectives).
  - c. Scientific basis/evidence related to topic (citations)
2. Abstract organization and internal consistency
  - a. General organization and abstract clarity
  - b. Alignment of learning objectives with content/teaching activities
3. Author Qualifications
