2021 ISONG Congress Abstract Review Criteria and Grading Guidelines

CRITERIA GUIDELINES

For research, the criteria are:

- Originality
- Scientific significance or merit
- Appropriateness or adequacy of design/approach and methods
- Application to the field
- Adequacy of description

For genomic application in an educational setting, the criteria are:

- Innovation/creativity
- Educational importance or merit
- Appropriateness educational application approach/program implementation
- Application to genetic/genomic education
- Adequacy of description

For genomic application in a clinical setting, the criteria are:

- Innovation/creativity
- Clinical importance or merit
- Appropriateness of clinical application approach/program implementation
- Application to genetic/genomic practice
- Adequacy of description

For policy, the criteria are:

- Originality
- Significance or merit
- Adequacy of policy analysis, initiative, process, approach, or change implementation
- Application to genetic/genomic nursing policy
- Adequacy of description

GRADING GUIDELINES

Please score each of the evaluation criteria on a 0-10 scale based on the following descriptions.

(Note: Three of the descriptors allow you flexibility in assigning a score. Only assign one number for each evaluation criteria):

- Superior (10)
- Outstanding/excellent (9)
- Very good (7 or 8)
- Good (6)
- Acceptable (4 or 5)
- Marginal (3)
- Inadequate (1 or 2)
- Not addressed (0)

Please provide comments to justify the score you assigned, particularly if you recommend the abstract NOT be accepted. Recommendation oral presentation /poster presentation /reject.
