

ISONG Clinical Care Grant Information

ISONG members working in the clinical arena are invited to apply for a \$750.00 grant to complete a clinical project in your area of expertise. The clinical project should help promote patient care and/or address a gap in genomic clinical care. Projects must be completed within one year and project success must be measurable.

Projects may include but not limited to:

- Quality improvement initiatives
- Clinical tool kits
- Patient education materials
- Improving delivery of care models

Applicant Requirements:

- Applicant must be a current member of ISONG and involved in clinical practice.
- Applicant must disclose if funding from ISONG for this project has been previously provided.
- Applicant must complete a **Letter of Intent** due no later than May 14, 2021.

Grant Submission Requirements:

- Applicant must submit the grant via email to the Professional Practice Committee co-chairs, Tina Mladenka at tinamladenka@isu.edu and Andrea Hartgraves at als5133@gmail.com - ONE PDF File that includes the application and project design/description (800 words maximum) should be submitted no later than Friday, June 25, 2021 (midnight EDT). The email subject line must include the last name of the Submitter and ISONG Grant 2021. Example: Jones ISONG Grant 2021

Awarding of grant funding is competitive and will be determined through peer review of proposals by members of the ISONG Professional Practice Committee. The impact to clinical care will be the primary criterion for funding decisions.
